MTCC 1113: The Casitas at Northtown I Board-Approved Doorbell Camera Specifications

About

These specs apply if an owner plans to replace the existing doorbell (the old unit) on the frame of the exterior door (**not** the corridor door) with a doorbell camera (the new unit).

Conditions

To qualify for this approval, the owner must discuss the plan with the Management office *before* purchasing and installing the new unit, and must sign a form to acknowledge that:

- 1. Any issue relating to installation, wiring, WiFi / Internet, clip storage, notification, repairs, etc. is the responsibility of the owner.
- 2. If the townhouse unit is sold, then the front door must be left with a working doorbell (with or w/o a camera) or else a chargeback will be imposed.

Specs

These specs are vendor neutral. Many models on the market today (Nest, Ring, Wyze, ...) meet them.

- 1. The old unit must be removed.
- 2. The new unit must be installed at the position of the old unit, not above it or below it.
- 3. The new unit can be wired or wireless and can reuse the wires of the old unit if needed.
- 4. The holes made for the old unit must be covered by the new unit.
- 5. The new unit must be less than 2" wide, less than 6" high, and less than 1.1" thick.
- 6. The new unit must be installed vertically on the frame without protruding beyond it, and must be aesthetically pleasing, e.g. not be crooked.
